The collection consists of correspondence to Douglas Ainslie from various persons including one letter from Ainslie to Constance Wilde.

Grant Duff Douglas Ainslie was born in Paris, France in 1865; BA, Oxford, 1886; became an English poet, critic, and diplomat; translated works of Benedetto Croce into English; publications include *Chosen Poems* (1928) and *The Conquest of Pleasure* (1942); died March 27, 1948.
