Subjects in the collection include African Americans and HIV/AIDS; anti-AIDS legislation; the ARC/AIDS Vigil; Asian/Pacific Islanders and HIV/AIDS; bathhouses and the bathhouse controversy of 1984; bibliographies; conspiracy theories; Hispanics/Latinos and HIV/AIDS; the international fight against HIV/AIDS; medical information; Native Americans and HIV/AIDS; needle exchange; prevention and education; protests and rallies; safe sex guidelines; religion and spirituality; support groups; and Women and HIV/AIDS.
