### **Conduct of the Interview**

Prior to the interview, Mrs. Flick had been sent a list of questions to give her an idea of the sort of topics the interview would cover. The interviewer and Mrs. Flick went over these questions briefly immediately before the interview. The interview covered most of the original questions and some others which arose during the course of the interview. There were two brief interruptions, one when the doorbell rang, and the other when Mrs. Flick left for a moment to attend to her mother, who lives at the house.

### **Editing**

Preliminary editing was done by the interviewer within a month of interview. This was limited to striking out incipient sentences and a few superfluous words such as "so" and "and" where their use encumbered the narrative, and occasional rewording for clarity. An exact transcript of the original interview is on file in the Manuscript Librarian's office. The tape is also available.
