Biography

The American Jewish Congress (AJC) was founded in 1916, and reorganized in 1920 and 1938. The groundwork for the Northern California Division was laid in the 1930s by Rabbis Saul White of Beth Shalom and Elliot Burstein of Beth Israel when they organized a boycott of German goods. The Division was officially founded in December 1943. The AJC's mission shifted somewhat over the years but the core was the promotion of "Jewish rights and freedom" within the U.S. and the support of the "Jewish Homeland." The organization's Civil Rights stand broadened over the years from a concern for Jewish Rights (American Jewish Yearbook, 1922) to the "elimination of all forms of racial and religious bigotry" (American Jewish Yearbook, 1995) and was referred to by one member as a Jewish ACLU. One of the AJC's primary money making activities was the sponsoring of tours of Israel and Jewish themed tours to other cultural and religious sites around the world.

The Northern California Division grew tremendously under the leadership of Executive Director Ephraim Margolin (1960-1964) and Divisional Director Joel Brooks (1967-1997). In 1960 Ephraim Margolin, Yale-educated lawyer and former Israeli Supreme Court Clerk, was recruited as both the West Coast Director of the AJC's Commission on Law and Social Action (CLSA) and Executive Director of the Northern California Division of the AJC. Margolin worked to expand the AJC's base, increasing membership and promoting the creation of numerous

local chapters. Margolin recruited a number of the emerging leaders in the progressive legal community to the AJC including Joe Grodin (later an AJC President). The AJC's Law Commentary published the first articles by a number of lawyers who would later become nationally prominent. Margolin held annual retreats with AJC members and leading legal authorities including the Attorney General which led to a number of major legal cases on employment, housing and church/state issues. The AJC was instrumental in the drafting of the first Fair Employment Practices Commission (FEPC) legislation and filed 30-40 briefs in progressive cases expanding out from the National AJC focus on Church/State issues. Margolin stepped down as director in 1964, but later served as President and remained active in the legal activities of the AJC and the CLSA.

In 1967 Joel Brooks became Northern California Divisional Director. Under Brooks the AJC expanded rapidly and branched out into a variety of service areas. The Experience Reserve Bank (ERB) was founded in 1969 to give free management and technical assistance to minorities, new immigrants, and veterans interested in owning and operating their own businesses. The Legal Assistance to the Elderly Project, established in 1974, provided free legal and social services on a non-sectarian basis to San Francisco's elderly poor. The AJC's Committee on Law and Social Action (CLSA) filed friend of the court briefs and worked on a variety of legal and social action issues. The AJC was also at the forefront of struggles on the behalf of both Soviet and Ethiopian Jews. Brooks, whose former service included a stint in the Israeli Army and work with a number of other Jewish agencies, liked the idea of doing things differently. He is proud of having recruited Hal Lipset, the nation's number one private eye (inventor of the martini microphone, authenticator of the Watergate Tapes, and head of a number of law enforcement associations), as President of the Division. The AJC was the only Jewish organization with which Lipset was involved. Brooks also lectured as an expert on the Black Jews of America.

The American Jewish Congress (AJC), Northern California Division records were donated by the AJC in 1969, with several additional donations over the succeeding years. Some AJC publicity materials sent to the WJHC were also added to the collection. Processing was done by at least two archivists over a period of years and was completed in 1999 by Julia Bazar.

Scope and Content

This collection contains minutes (1960-1982, incomplete), financial records, membership records, annual reports, articles, programs, newsletters, press releases, clippings, correspondence, briefs and published material, and some photographs. One sound recording on a thin plastic disc is also included in the collection.

The material is divided into five series: Corporate Records, Newsletters and Press Releases, Oral History Project, Subject Files and Correspondence. Most of the materials cover the 1970s through the mid 1980s, with some material from the early 1960s as well.

The collection documents the activities of the AJC from 1960 through the mid-1980s. The majority of the material concerns events from the mid- to late-1970s. The largest series consists of subject files containing of correspondence, flyers, clippings, pamphlets and other background materials relating to AJC events, programs and areas of interest. Correspondence files provide additional information on AJC activities and concerns, as well as documenting the organizational structure and the relationship between the national and local offices. Of special interest are materials relating to the Falashas (Ethiopian Jews), Soviet Jewry, Black-Jewish Relationships, Affirmative Action, Black Jews in the United States, church-state affairs, Zionism, education, and Nazism in San Francisco. The Experience Reserve Bank (ERB) and the Legal Assistance to the Elderly programs are also documented, as are the AJC's annual Kallah (retreat) and the activities of various chapters.

Also of interest are documents pertaining to the Jews of Eastern Europe Oral History Project co-sponsored by the AJC and the WJHC. Other examples of Magnes Museum/AJC cooperation and connection are scattered throughout the collection.

Condition Report

The collection is generally in good condition except for a number of deteriorating clippings and older thermal photocopies which need preservation photocopying. A few photographs are scattered throughout the collection and one audio recording (plastic phonograph disc) is also included in the collection.

Membership records also include lists of members and potential members, forms and a calendar and list of San Francisco synagogues and rabbis.

Scope and Content Note

This series contains a wide variety of clippings, letters, bulletins, tickets, announcements and other documents covering the full range of activities and events sponsored by the AJC. This series includes both information and program files. Folders are arranged alphabetically by subject. Some subjects are divided into sub-series. These include Chapters (arranged alphabetically by location), Commission on Law and Social Action (CLSA) files (some of which duplicate subjects found elsewhere), Experience Reserve Bank (ERB) files, and Programs which includes individual event folders for 1979-1980 arranged chronologically.

The four folders labeled Newspaper Articles and Clippings contain information on AJC events. Other folders may include clippings as well. The Activities files consist of flyers received by the WJHC documenting AJC events. Other topics of special note are: Affirmative Action (also see CLSA), the Arab Economic Boycott, Black/Jewish Relations, Complaints about a Spartan Dodge ad which ran on Channel 36 in 1972, the Black Panthers and Angela Davis, the Falasha (Ethiopian Jews), Jewish Film Festivals and various film projects, responses to a planned meeting of Holocaust Debunkers (Institute of Historical Review), Informational and Cultural projects related to Israel and Israelis in the U.S., various Jewish welfare organizations and concerns including the groundbreaking Legal Assistance to the Elderly Project, religion in the schools and other Church/State Issues, programs and events supporting Soviet Jews including a Benefit Run, and materials pertaining to the activities of the Women's Division.

Correspondence, 1960-1983**Physical Description:** 52 folders**Scope and Content Note**

This series contains both incoming and outgoing correspondence. Correspondence includes letters and memos sent between the local and national offices, members, board members, officers, and others. Topics covered include internal structural matters, event planning, controversies, public relations, budget, staffing and more. Most of the correspondence relates to Joel Brooks' tenure as Director, but there are a few files with correspondence between Ephraim Margolin and the National office (1960-1962), and concerning a Seattle law case (1960-1962). There is no extant correspondence from 1963 to 1968 and only a scattered correspondence from 1969 to March of 1972. Between 1972 and 1978 correspondence was divided into National or New York Correspondence and Local Correspondence. There is a single correspondence run from 1979 and 1980, and starting in 1981 a separate file was kept labeled Memoranda. Subject matter crosses over these categories and both should be examined when trying to track specific subjects. Other correspondence can be found in various subject folders.
