Introduction

In the spring and fall of 1971, Elise Stern Haas donated eight boxes of materials that would form the core of her mother, Rosalie Meyer Stern's, collection. Most of this material was letters, many of which had been previously inventoried at the Haas home by Celeste MacLeod, former archivist at the Western Jewish History Center. In 1975, Haas deposited additional materials (the remainder of her mother's papers, as well as her personal papers and those of her husband, Walter) that were incorporated into the existing collection. News clippings and publications about the Haas and Stern families have been added to the collection since that time. In 1996 Western Jewish History Center staff began work on an inventory and the finding guide and final collection processing was completed in 1997.

Access

Collection is open for research by appointment only every Monday-Thursday, except for those Jewish and Federal holidays when it is closed.

Scope and Content

This collection is comprised of correspondence, photographs, diaries, genealogies, ephemera, and newspaper clippings, books and booklets. Letters constitute the bulk of the material. Most of the collection centers on Rosalie Meyer Stern's life as a daughter, sister, cousin, mother, and grandmother. There is relatively little material from her role as a civic activist (SF Recreation and Park Commissioner, board member of Associated Charities, philanthropist in the fields of education, music, and recreation, a founder of the San Francisco Opera Association, on the Women's Board of the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, and Associate Field Director of Military Relief for the American Red Cross). Rosalie's daughter, Elise Stern Haas, is a secondary focus of the collection.

The letters, most of which were written to Rosalie Meyer Stern, provide a picture of her life and that of three to four generations of her extended family, the Meyers, Sterns, Haas', and Newmarks. The earliest, to Rosalie's father Eugene from his mother Zephora, predates her birth by two years. The most recent one, dated 1964, is an inquiry about her French ancestors from Rosalie's daughter, Elise. The majority of the letters were written by family members to Rosalie between 1880 and 1930. While many of the letters were penned from Los Angeles, there are also those that were written by relatives living in San Francisco, New York, St. Louis, and France, and some travel letters from various parts of the United States and from abroad.

There are letters from or about Rosalie's paternal aunt and uncle, Ernestine and Leon Zadoc Kahn, the Grand Rabbi of France, Judah Magnes, Felix Frankfurter, Florence Prag Kahn, Justice Brandeis, Michael Stein (Gertrude's brother), and Levi Straus.

There is extensive correspondence from Rosalie's parents, Eugene and Harriet Newmark Meyer; Rosalie's brothers, Eugene, Jr. (an appointed government official and owner of the Washington Post), Walter (an investment banker), Edgar (who died on the Titanic); and her sisters, all of whom married into prominent Jewish families, Elise (married to Abraham Stern, Sigmund's brother and later to De Souza Dantes), Florence (a philanthropist married to George Blumenthal), Ruth (Mrs. George Cook), and Aline (Mrs. Charles Liebman). There is also a fair amount of correspondence from and to Rosalie's daughter and son-in-law, Elise Stern and Walter Haas.

The other major component of the collection is "social life ephemera," a category of items which give a picture of the Meyer-Stern-Haas' social milieu. There are invitations to weddings and other social events, calling and business cards, dance cards, ocean liner passenger lists, itineraries, as well as wills, lists of condolence senders, a few financial records, and information about clubs and societies.

The balance of the collection contains diaries, biographical information, including her brother Walter's handwritten memoirs, genealogies, and a box of photographs of family members from several generations, from Rosalie's maternal grandparents (1885?) to travel photos from the 1950s.

The collection contains some documents in French, Yiddish, Hebrew, and German.

Condition Report

Overall, the collection is in relatively good condition. The collection contains many telegrams that are deteriorating due to acidic paper and probably should be copied on to acid free paper.

Series I: Correspondence, 1867-1965

Physical Description: 142 folders

Scope and Content Note

This series is divided into three sub-series: (1) Rosalie Meyer Stern, (2) Elise Stern & Walter Haas, and (3) Other People. Each sub-series has been filed chronologically and incoming and outgoing letters are separated. Where possible, letters from one person sent during the course of a year have been kept together. Some folders that contain correspondence from a variety of people have a listing of correspondents in the front of the folder.

Series II: Social Life Ephemera, 1875-1956

Physical Description: 39 folders

Scope and Content Note

This series contains an assortment of materials that document Rosalie Meyer Stern's social and family life, including invitations, programs, dance cards, travel itineraries, calling cards, and wills.

Series III: Diaries, 1881-1892

Physical Description: 3 folders

Scope and Content Note

This series contains Rosalie's diaries including one from January to March 1886, written while living in San Francisco, one from her trip to Paris with Elise and Eugene Meyer in 1891-1892, and fragments written on special occasions during 1881-1888, and undated.

Series IV: Biographical Material, 1943-1964

Physical Description: 9 folders

Scope and Content Note

This series contains mostly unpublished biographical material including family histories and memoirs of the extended Meyer-Newmark family. "Ship's Log Around the Horn 1853" is the published version of the diary kept by Rosalie's maternal grandfather, Meyer Newmark, on his trip as a 12 year old from New York to San Francisco. There is a undated, typed manuscript, written by Rosalie, which includes an account of the 1906 earthquake and her introduction to philanthropy and social work by Jessica Peixotto and Katherine Felton.

Scope and Content Note

This series contains a number of handwritten genealogies of the extended Meyer-Newmark family.

This series contains a variety of papers ranging from an academic paper by Edgar Meyer, a series of short essays by Rosalie Meyer Stern, and government related documents from Eugene Meyer, Jr.

This series is comprised of photographs of Rosalie's family. There is a folder containing pictures that may have been taken by Ansel Adams, a friend of the family.

This series contains books, booklets, and pamphlets ranging from those in French pertaining to Leon Zadoc Kahn, the Grand Rabbi of France who testified at the Dreyfus trial, to books belonging to Rosalie, to an issue of *Encore, Performing Arts Quarterly* that contains substantial articles about Rosalie Meyer Stern.
