Collection consists of some 95 manuscripts, including records of business correspondence, account books, local histories, folklore, dictionaries, commentaries, statistical information (particularly in Armenian communities in India), and archival papers, including correspondence, business papers, encyclicals, government edicts, photographs, and other materials concerned with the Iranian-Armenian and Indian-Armenian communities. The entire collection is in Armenian.
