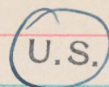

Is the owner of a large produce market on East 14th. St in San Leandro which was being operated for him by a manager and a bookkeeper accountant. Not having received the necessary reports on the operation of this market, he requested that an investigation be made and that he be informed as to the present ~~stat~~ status fo the market and a report made to him on its operations, This investigation was made after considerable time, the financial report of the condition of the market was received and forwarded to Nakamura. He then ~~reported~~ requested that a Certified Public Accountant be employed to make a complete audit of the business although there was no indication in the financial report submitted by his bookkeeper or as a result of our investigation that the business was not beinr run efficiently. The public accountants that he selected were obtained & their report on the condition of the business was submitted to Nakamura. Both the bookkeeper's and the public accountants' report indicated that this business was being handled efficient

ly and that it was netting Nakamura \$1,000 per month. Nakamura however, requested that his bookkeeper-accountant who had previously held his power of attorney be discontinued in the management of the business and the books and records be obtained from him. This was accomplished and Nakamura employed a new bookkeeper-accountant.

Walker had decided to sell wine tank without permission of evacuee. Upon arriving on ranch we found that the Walkers had decided to ~~sell~~ everything along with evacuee stored goods and had moved to Texas. The people who bought ranch had no knowlegde of evacuee stored goods. We could not find anything in shed or house that belonged to the evacuee. The people infomrmed us that Walker held a small sale of evacuee property. Legal action should be brought against Walker.

Barton to Hatch, Dec. 27 1943: Nakao states that he did not have any personal property or household goods in the house, but states that he did have some light farm machinery and tools in the shed. He also states that the wine tank was his property. This man is quite philosophical about the loss of his property and will appreciate anythinhg that can be done to assist him.
